
Odessa is the home of champion athletes such as Olympic Silver Medalist **Toby Stevenson** and NFL greats **Roy Williams**, **Marcus Cannon** and **Bront Bird**. We're proud of all of our sports teams and their achievements. In fact, Odessa was the setting for both the national best-selling book and feature film **Friday Night Lights**.

Odessa is located in the geographic region known as the Permian Basin. In 1926, the discovery of oil propelled the city into an enviable destination. Odessa quickly became the service, workforce, transportation, supply and manufacturing center of the Permian Basin. Today, it continues to be considered one of the major oil field technology centers in the world.

Odessa at a Glance

Odessa is located in Ector County midway between Fort Worth and El Paso. It is the 29th largest city in Texas with a population more than 125,000.

Odessa is approximately 2,900 feet above sea level. The climate is mild and semi-arid with summer average temperatures ranging from the 60s to the upper-90s, and winter average temperatures ranging from the low-30s to the upper-50s.
